

## **WHO CAN PLAY?**

All IAFF Members are eligible to participate in NFFSC Tournaments.

Retired firefighters with proof of retirement from service may play in tournaments.

Professional Firefighters may play.

## **INELIGIBLE ENTRY OR PARTICIPATION**

No Military and no Volunteers

Unqualified Persons: If a person attempts to enter or enters the National Firefighter Softball Conference (NFFSC) when he/she does not qualify for entry, that person is immediately disqualified from competition and shall be permanently disqualified from future NFFSC event.

If it is discovered that a team member or competitor has entered and does not qualify for entry into the NFFSC (i.e., non-firefighter) that team, and all of its members are immediately disqualified from all competition in the current NFFSC and shall be subject to appropriate disciplinary action.

If another competitor, team captain or coach allows a person to join the team, but who is ineligible for that team, all of its members are immediately disqualified from all competition in the current NFFSC and shall be subject to appropriate disciplinary action.

Any team that enters a player that does not meet the NFFSC rules that are stated will have to forfeit and may be subject to 1 year suspension from playing in NFFSC events.

## **VERIFIED IDENTITY**

SPORT VENUE ID'S NEEDED.

Each competitor must check in before the start of the Tournament (i.e., host hotel / at fields.) During check-in, each competitor will show the NFFSC issued ID, Department ID / Pay Stub, Driver's License. Failure to do so will prohibit participation until the requirement is satisfied.
